WHY?

- Every second matters. If a loved one wanted to take the courageous step to ask for help, they would have to dial 1-800-273-8255 to reach the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline.
- Effective July 2022, the Federal Communications Commission has designated "988" as the new phone number for the Lifeline; similar to "911" for emergency personnel.
- To do this, all local phone calls on Guam must include the 671-area code.
- This will ensure calls to 988 reach Guam's Lifeline Crisis Center (GBHWC) for urgent mental health needs.

WHY?

- Effective January 15, 2022, the Federal Communications Commission has designated "988" as the new phone number for the Lifeline; similar to "911" for emergency personnel.
- To do this, all local phone calls on CNMI must include the 670-area code.
- While not yet mandated, the CNMI may be required to implement 10-Digit Dialing. This adoption is a preemptive measure to ensure a smooth transition.
